## How to Report a Crime to the Civic Association Board

The board wants to hear from you if a crime occurs, so we can track our stats and optimize our patrol hours. *However, there is no same day or emergency service.* This Q&A is to clarify the process.

Q: What is the nature of our patrol service?

A: The Civic Association pays for 30 hours of service per week from off-duty HPD officers, led by Officer Craig Thompson. Officer Thompson has been patrolling for us for 25 years. There are four officers in rotation.

Q: What duties do the officers perform?

A: A typical shift includes driving around streets to provide a presence, monitoring entrances off Willowbend/ Kingfisher/ Benning, and visiting with residents regarding previously reported complaints.

Q: I've just had a break-in. Is there an emergency number to reach our patrol?

A: No. Our patrol is 30 hours per week (not 24 hours per day/7 days per week). Call 911 or the HPD non-emergency police at 713-884-3131. Then, report by email to the Civic Association so we can follow up with you later.

Q: How to I report a crime to the Civic Association?

A: Email precinct287ca@gmail.com. Our secretary usually responds in one business day.

Q: What happens after I report?

A: Lead patrol Officer Thompson makes an effort to visit every crime victim in our neighborhood to advise/collect more information within a few days.

Q: I see a suspicious person walking around. Is there a way to check if our patrol officers are on duty?

A: No. Lead patrol Officer Thompson and the other officers he works with have a rotating schedule, and do not provide their personal numbers. There is no central call center.

Q: Why do we have a patrol if there is no way to contact them in real time?

A: Limited finances prevent us from having 24-hour patrol and central call center. There are companies that provide this service, but we are nowhere near able to afford a 24-hour service. Additionally, there are benefits to having real HPD officers, as opposed to a security service.

Q: What is the purpose of paying for a patrol at all, if it is not full-time and cannot respond immediately to crimes?

A: Our patrol serves as a crime deterrent and presence (criminals do not know the hours patrolled) and provides monitoring and advising. The Board has a security

meeting twice yearly to review trends and optimal patrol hours (making the most of our limited funds).

The patrol contributes to the overall well-being of the neighborhood through years of resident contacts by our lead patrol Officer Thompson. Many incidents of our (low rates) of criminal activity and nuisances have come from "within," meaning relatives or visitors of our residents, or the residents themselves. Officer Thompson has been able to diffuse situations regarding neighbor disputes, elderly welfare checks, families with drug and alcohol problems, advising domestic violence victims, and other actions that contribute to the well-being of our neighborhood.
